Curves

Manos Del Uruguay Silk Blend

This casual sweater is knitted in single rib for beautiful drape. The exquisite silk/merino blend yarn is so light and warm, this will quickly become your favourite weekend sweater.

Sizes:

16[18:20:22:24]

Actual sweater measurements:

Bust: 106[111:116:121:126]cm

(41.5[43.5:45.5:47.5:49.5]ins)

Overall Length 64[67:70:73:76]

cm (25[26.5:27.5:28.75:30]ins)

Yarn

Manos del Uruguay Silk Blend

100gm

7[7:8:9:9] skeins in shade 6610

Needles

Pair of 4.5mm needles.

2 long stitch holders

2 large safety pins

Artesano recomend Brittany Needles.

Note: Yarn amounts are approximate.

Tension:

30 sts and 28 rows to 10cm over

Single Rib using 4.25mm needle.

Use larger or smaller needles if necessary to obtain correct tension.

Abbreviations:

St(s) = Stitch(es)

K = knit

P = purl

RS = right side of garment

WS = wrong side of garment

Dec 1 = K or p the next two stitches together

Inc 1 = increase by knitting or purling twice into the next stitch. Single rib = *K1, P1 repeat from * to end of row. Always start the next row with opposite stitch you finished on.

Back

□

With 4.25 needles, cast on 162[168:176:184:192] stitches. Single rib throughout.

*Work 9[10:9:9:8] rows. Next row, dec 1 at each side.

Repeat from * 5[4:5:5:6] times more. (150[158:164:172:178] sts

Continue straight until back measures 21[22:23:24:25] cm

** Inc 1 st at each end of the next and every following 9th row until there are (158[166:172:182:188] sts

Continue straight until back measures 40[42:44:46:48] cm.

Armhole shaping

Cast off 7[8:8:9:9] sts at the beginning of the next two rows.

Work 10[10:11:11:11] rows, dec 1 at each end of every row.

Work 10[12:12:12:12] rows, dec 1 at each end of every alternate row. (114[118:122:130:136] sts

□

Work straight until back measures 21.5[22.5:23.5:24.5:26] cm from beginning of Armhole.

Neck shaping

Work 48[49:51:54:57] sts. Slip the next 18[20:20:22:22] sts onto a stitch holder.

Turn and work on the first 48[49:51:54:57] sts as follows

Work 1 row.

Row 1: Cast off 13[13:13:14:15] sts at neck edge and work to end.

Row 2: Work 1 row.

Row 3: Cast off 6[6:7:7] sts at neck edge and work to end.

Row 4: work 1 row.

Row 5: Cast off remaining 29[30:31:33:34] sts.

Rejoin yarn and the remaining 48[49:51:54:57] sts and repeat rows 1 to 5.

Front

Work as Back from □ to □.

Neck shaping

Work 57[59:61:65:68] sts.

Slip remaining 57[59:61:65:68] sts into a stitch holder. Turn.

**Continue single rib on the first set of 57[59:61:65:68] sts until work measures

14.5[15.5:16.5:17:17.5] cm from start of Armhole shaping ending at neck edge.

Row 1: Work the first 10[11:12:12:12] sts and then slip

them onto a safety pin. Work to end.

Row 2: Work 1 row.

Row 3: Cast off 6[6:6:6:7] sts at neck edge and work to end.

Row 4: Work 1 row

Row 5: Cast off 3[3:3:4:5] sts at neck edge and work to end.

Row 6: Work 1 row

Row 7: Cast off 3[3:3:4:4] sts at neck edge and work to end.

Rows 8-13: Dec 1 at neck edge on every row. (29[30:31:33:34] sts)

Continue straight until work measures 23.5[24.5:25.5:27:27.5] cm from beginning of Armhole shaping.

Cast off remaining

29[30:31:33:34] sts**

Slip remaining stitches from stitch holder onto needle so that you will be starting the next row at the neck edge.

Work from ** to ** to mirror shapings on the first side.

Sleeves (knit 2 at the same time)

With 4.25mm needles cast on 78[80:84:88:92] sts

Working in single rib throughout, increase 1 stitch at each end of every 5th row until there are 122[128:134:140:144] sts.

Continue straight until work measures 44[46.5:48.5:50.5:52.5] cm.

Cast off 9[9:9:10:10] sts at the beginning of the next two rows. (104[110:116:120:124]sts)

Work 12[13:14:14:14] rows, dec 1 at each end of every row. (80[84:88:92:96]sts)

Work 14[14:14:16:18] rows, dec 1 at each end of every alternate row (66[70:74:76:78]sts)

Work 12[13:14:14:14] rows, dec 1 at each end of every row. (42[44:46:48:50] sts)

Cast off 3 sts at the beginning of the next two rows (36[38:40:42:44] sts

Cast off remaining sts.

Collar

With right sides facing, sew up shoulder seams.

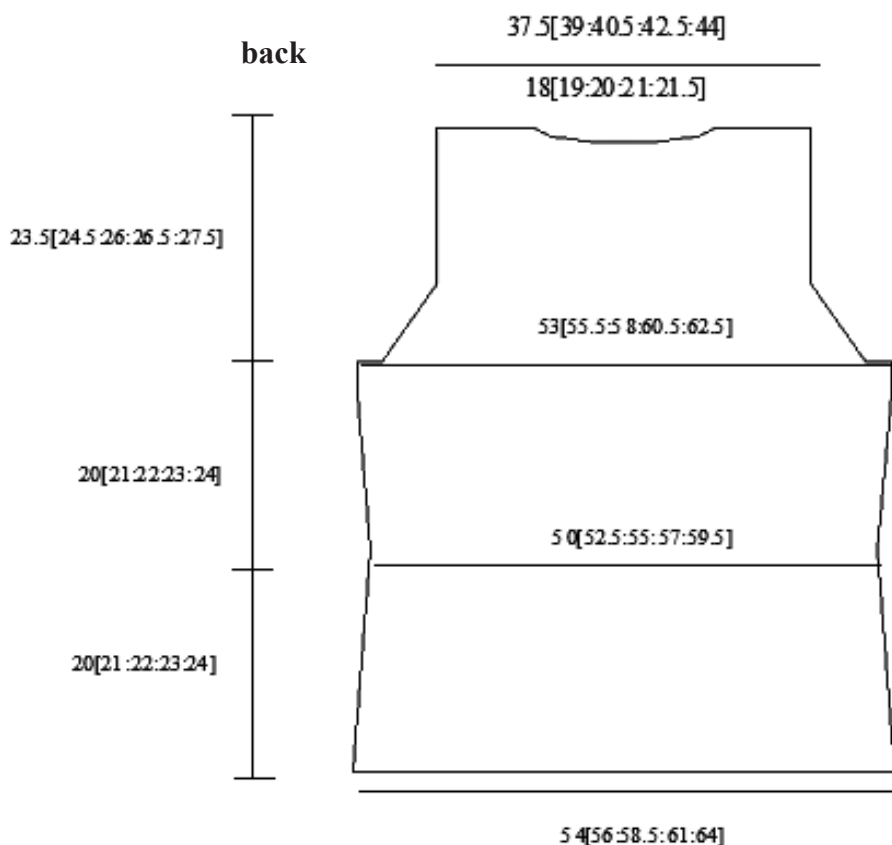
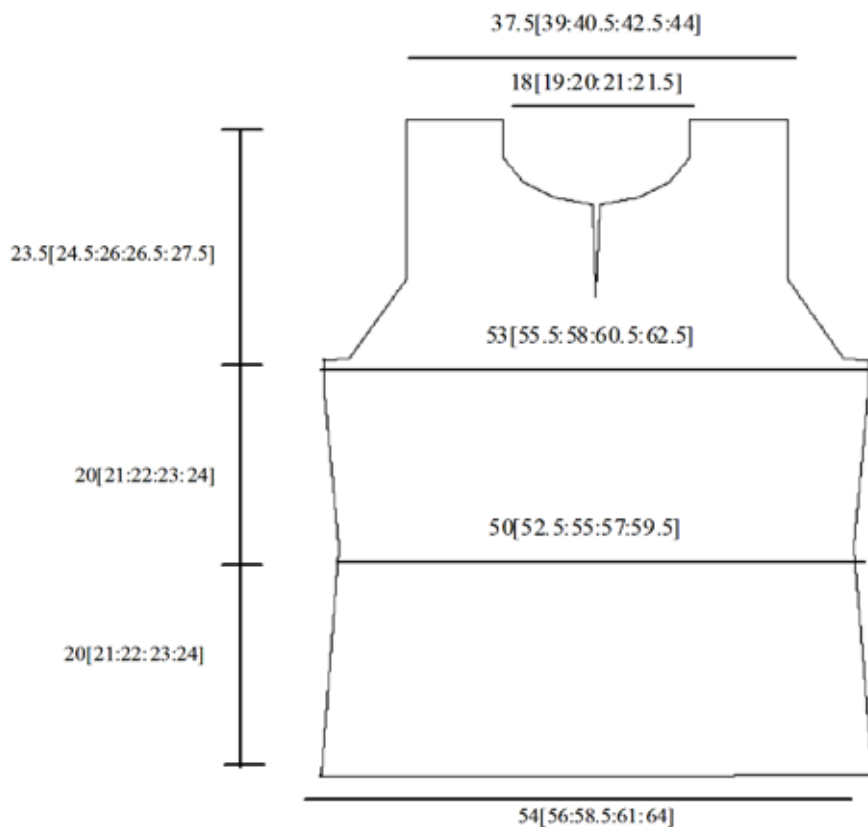
With right side facing, and working in single rib, pick up stitches as

follows:

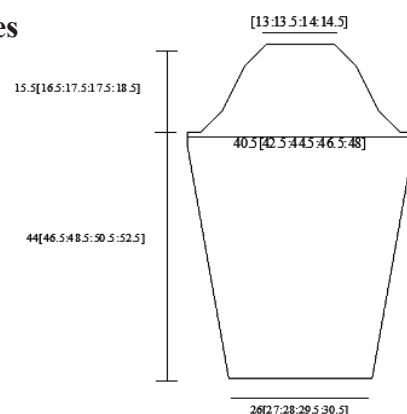
10[11:12:12:12] sts from the front safety pin
 32[33:34:35:36] sts up to shoulder seam
 19[20:20:21:22] sts from shoulder seam to stitch holder
 18[20:20:22:22] sts from stitch holder
 19[20:20:21:22] sts up to shoulder seam
 32[33:34:35:36] sts to safety pin
 10[11:12:12:12] sts from safety pin. (140[148:152:158:162] sts)
 Continue in single rib until collar measures 10[10:10.5:11:11] cm.
 Cast off in single rib.

To make up

With RS together, pin each sleeve evenly into its armhole and stitch seam. Lightly press seam from the wrong side in accordance with the ball band instructions.
 With RS together, pin and stitch each side seam. Press seam lightly from the inside. Do not press garment.

Important:

We recommend buying enough yarn to complete a project. If there is a great difference between skeins, we recommend knitting two rows from one skein and two rows from another skein to give an overall blended effect.
