Materials:

2 x 100g Manos Wool Clasica
(**Yarn A:** Colour: 2450 Volga)
2 x 100g Manos Wool Clasica
(**Yarn B:** Colour: 2672 Thames)
2 x 100g Manos Wool Clasica
(**Yarn C:** Colour: 2444 Zambezi)
2 x 100g Manos Wool Clasica
(**Yarn D:** Colour: 2412 Hudson)
6 mm, 100cm circular needle
Optional: 6mm crochet hook

Tension:

16sts x 20 rows over 10cm on
6mm needles

Abbreviations:

RS – right side

WS – wrong side

K – knit

P – purl

St st – stocking stitch (knit on the right side, purl on the wrong side)

K2tog – knit two together

P2tog – purl two together

P2togtbl – purl two together through back of loop

Sl1, K1, pssso – slip the first stitch, knit the next stitch, then pass the slipped stitch over the knit stitch

Yo – yarn over

Yrn – yarn round needle

Dec – decrease

Inc – increase

PM – place marke

Dc – double crochet

To make shawl:

Using 6mm circular needle, cast on 250 sts and work each stitch pattern as follows:

Ridged Eyelet Border in **Yarn A**

1) K

2) K

3) K

4) *P2tog, yo, repeat from * to last 2 sts, P2

5) K

6) K

7) K

8) P

Repeat Row 1-6 once more, break yarn

Purse Stitch in **Yarn B**

1) P1, * yrn, P2tog, repeat from * to last st, P1

Repeat this row seven more times, break yarn

Fleck Stitch in **Yarn C**

1) K

2) P

3) K1, * P1, K1, repeat from * to end of row

4) P

Repeat Rows 1-4, twice more, break yarn

Diamond Rib in **Yarn D**

1) P4, * K2tog, (K1, yo), X 2, sl1, K1, pssso, P2, repeat from * to last 3 sts, P3

2) (And on every alternate row) K5, * P7, K2, repeat from * to last 2 sts, K2

3) P4, * K2tog, yo, K3, yo, sl1, K1, pssso, P2, repeat from * to last 3 sts, P3

5) P4, * K1, yo, sl1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yo, K1, P2, repeat from * to last 3 sts, P3

7) P4, * K2, yo, sl1, K2tog, pssso, yo, K2, P2, repeat from * to last 3 sts, P3

8) K5, * P7, K2, repeat from * to last 3 sts, K3

Repeat Rows 1 -8 once more, break yarn

Garner Stitch in **Yarn A**

Knit 6 rows, break yarn

Little Fountain Stitch in **Yarn B**

1) K1, * yo, K3, yo, K1, repeat from * to last st, K1

2) P

3) K2, sl1, K2tog, pssso, * K3, sl1, K2tog, pssso, repeat from * to last 3 sts, K3

4) P

Repeat Rows 1-4 once more, break yarn

Vertical Bar Lines in **Yarn C**

1) P2, * K2, P2, repeat from * to end of the row

2) K2, * keeping yarn to the back, slip next 2 sts purlwise, K2, repeat from * to the end of the row

Repeat Rows 1 and 2, three more times, break yarn

Simple Lace in **Yarn D**

1) K1, * K2tog, (yo) X2, K2tog, repeat from * to last st, K1

2) P1, * P2, K1, P1, repeat from * to last st, P1

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 once more, break yarn

Fishtail Lace in **Yarn A**

1) K1, * yo, K2, sl1, K2tog, pssso, K2, yo, K1, repeat from * to last st, K1

2) P

3) K2, * yo, K1, sl1, K2tog, pssso, K1, yo, K3, repeat from * to end of the row

4) P

5) K3, * yo, sl1, K2tog, pssso, yo, K5, repeat from * to last 7 sts, yo, sl1, K2tog, yo, K4

6) P

Repeat Rows 1-6 once more, break yarn

Stocking Stitch Triangles in **Yarn B**

1) K

2) * K1, P4, repeat from * to end of the row

3) * K3, P2, repeat from * to end of the row

4) * K3, P2, repeat from * to end of the row

5) * K1, P4, repeat from * to end of the row

6) K

Repeat Rows 1-6 once more, break yarn

Gate and Ladder Stitch in **Yarn C**

1) K

2) P

3) K3, K2tog, (yo) X2, K3, * K3tog, K3, (yo) X2, K3, repeat from * to last 6 sts, K3tog, K3

4) P3, K1, * P8, K1, repeat from * to last 3 sts, P3

Repeat Rows 3 and 4 twice, then Rows 1 and 2 once more more, break yarn

Tile Stitch in **Yarn D**

1) K4, * P2, K4, repeat from * to end of the row

2) P4, * K2, P4, repeat from * to end of the row

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 once more

5) P4, * K2, P4, repeat from * to end of the row

6) K4, * P2, K4, repeat from * to end of the row
Repeat Rows 5 and 6 once more, break yarn

Ridged Lace in Yarn A

- 1)** K1, * yo, K2tog, repeat from * to last st, K1
 - 2)** P1, * yrn, P2tog, repeat from * to last st, P1
- Repeat Row 1 and 2 once more, break yarn

Pillar Stitch in Yarn B

- 1)** K
 - 2)** P
 - 3)** K1, * yo, K2, pass yo over K2, repeat from * to last st, K1
- Repeat Rows 2 and 3 once more, break yarn

Double Lace Rib in Yarn C

- 1)** (WS) P
- 2)** K2, * P1, yo, K2togtbl, P1, K2, repeat from * to last 2 sts, K2
- 3)** P4, * K1, P2, repeat from * to end of the row
- 4)** K2, * P1, K2tog, yrn, P1, K2, repeat from * to last 2 sts, K2
- 5)** P4, * K1, P2, repeat from * to end of the row

Cast off loosely

Optional Scalloped edging
Using 6mm crochet hook and **Yarn D**, with WS facing, work 70 dc evenly across one short edge, turn, make 3 ch, miss first st at base of 3 ch and *work 3 tr into next st, miss next st, repeat from * across the edge to end.

Finish off.

Work second edging to match.

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Important:

We recommend buying enough yarn to complete a project. If there is a great difference between skeins, we recommend knitting two rows from one skein and two rows from another skein to give an overall blended effect.
