WOOL
CLASICA

Sizes:

S (M, L, XL, 2X, 3X)

Finished Bust:36 (40, 44, 48, 52, 56)in
91.5 (101.5, 111.75, 122, 132, 142)cm**Total Length**25 (26.75, 28.5, 29.75, 32)in
63.5 (66, 72.5, 75.7, 81.25)cm**Materials:**8 (9, 10, 11, 13, 15) x 100g Manos Wool Clasica (Colour: 2370 Mississippi) 6 mm needles, or size needed to obtain correct tension
1 stitch holder
Large tapestry needle
4 large wooden buttons**Tension:**

16 sts x 20 rows over 4in, 10cm in Stocking Stitch on 6mm needles, after blocking.

Abbreviations:**RS** – right side**WS** – wrong side**K** – knit**P** – purl**St st** – stocking stitch (knit on the right side, purl on the wrong side)**K2tog** – knit two together**P2tog** – purl two together**P2togtbl** – purl two together through back of loops**Sl1, k1, pssso** – slip the first stitch, knit the next stitch, then pass the slipped stitch over the knit stitch**Yo** - yarn over**Dec** – decrease**Inc** – increase**PM** – place marker**Moss St** – (K1, p1) across. On the following row, work all knit sts as purl and all purl sts as knit.**Lace Panel****Row 1 (RS):** K3, (k2tog, yo) twice, sl1, k1, pssso, k3.**Row 2:** P2, p2togtbl, yo, p1, inc in next st by knitting into the front and back of the stitch, p1, yo, p2tog, p2.**Row 3:** K1, k2tog, yo, k6, yo, sl1, k1, pssso, k1.**Row 4:** P2togtbl, yo, p8, yo, p2tog.**Row 5:** K1, yo, k3, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k3, yo, k1.**Row 6:** P2, yo, p2, p2tog tbl, p2tog, p2, yo, p2.**Row 7:** K3, yo, k1, k2tog, sl1, k1, pssso, k1, yo, k3.**Row 8:** P4, yo, p2tog tbl, p2tog, yo, p4. Rep Rows 1-8 for pattern.**LEFT FRONT**

Cast on 58 (62, 69, 72, 79, 86) sts.

Row 1: K1(2,3,3,4,5), *PM, work Lace Panel, PM, k7(8,10,11,13,15); repeat from * twice more.

Working all other stitches except Lace Panels in St st, work Rows 2-8 of Lace

Panel, then repeat Rows 1-8 once more, slipping all markers as you come to them.

****Dec Row:** K1(2,3,3,4,5), *work Lace Panel, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to 2 sts before next marker, k2tog; rep from * once more, work Lace Panel, k7(8,10,11,13,15). Work the next 17 (17, 15, 15, 15, 13) rows even in pattern. Rep from ** 1 (2, 3, 3, 3, 4) times more. Work 0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 2) rows even in pattern.**Size S Only:****Next Dec Rnd:** K1, *work Lace Panel, sl1, k2tog, pssso; rep from * once more, work Lace Panel, k7. Work 19 rows even in pattern.**All Sizes:**

46 (50, 53, 56, 63, 66) sts. Work 2 rows in St st, removing markers along the row.

Next row (RS): K5(7,10,8,12,9), *k2tog, k1(1,1,2,1,2); repeat from * to last 5 (7, 10, 8, 12, 9) sts, knit to end. 34 (38, 42, 46, 50, 54) sts**Next row:** Purl.

Work 20 (20, 20, 20, 24, 24) rows in St st, ending with a WS row.

Shape Armhole

Cast off 4 (4, 5, 6, 7, 8) sts at the beginning of the next row. 30 (34, 37, 40, 43, 46) sts

Next row: Purl.**Next row (RS):** K2, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to end of row.**Next row:** Purl.

Repeat the last 2 rows 3 (5, 6, 7, 8, 9) times more. 26 (28, 30, 32, 34, 36) sts Work straight until the armhole measures 6.5 (7, 7.25, 7.25, 7.75, 8)in, 16.5 (17.75, 18.5, 18.5, 19.75, 20.25)cm, ending with a RS row.

Neck Shaping

Cast off 4 (4, 5, 6, 8, 8) sts at the beginning of the next row. 22 (24, 25, 26, 26, 28) sts

Dec 1 st at neck edge on every row until 18 (20, 22, 22, 22, 23) sts remain, then work even until armhole measures 8.5 (9, 9.5, 10, 10.5, 10.75)in, 21.5 (23, 24, 25.5, 26.75, 27.25)cm, ending with a WS row.

Cast off 9 (10, 11, 11, 11, 12) sts at the beginning of the next row. Purl 1 row. Cast off remaining 9 (10, 11, 11, 11, 11) sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Cast on 58 (62, 69, 72, 79, 86) sts.

Row 1: *K7(8,10,11,13,15), PM, work Lace Panel, PM; rep from * twice more, k1(2,3,3,4,5).

Working all other stitches except Lace Panels in St st, work Rows 2-8 of Lace Panel, then repeat Rows 1-8 once more, slipping all markers as you come to them.

****Dec Row:** *K7(8,10,11,13,15), *work Lace Panel, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to 2 sts before next marker, k2tog; rep from * once more, work Lace Panel, k1(2,3,3,4,5). Work the next 17 (17, 15, 15, 15, 13) rows even in pattern. Rep from ** 1 (2, 3, 3, 3, 4) times more. Work 0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 2) rows even in pattern.**Size S Only:****Next Dec Rnd:** K7, *work Lace Panel, sl1, k2tog, pssso; rep from * once more, work Lace Panel, k1. Work 19 rows even in pattern.**All Sizes:**

46 (50, 53, 56, 63, 66) sts. Work 2 rows in St st, removing markers along the row.

Next row (RS): K5(7,10,8,12,9), *k2tog, k1(1,1,2,1,2), repeat from * to last 5 (7, 10, 8, 12, 9) sts, knit to end. 34 (38, 42, 46, 50, 54) sts**Next row:** Purl.

Work 21 (21, 21, 21, 25, 25) rows in St st, ending with a RS row.

Shape Armhole

Cast off 4 (4, 5, 6, 7, 8) sts at the beginning of the next row. 30 (34, 37, 40, 43, 46) sts

Next row (RS): Knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2.**Next row:** Purl.

Repeat the last 2 rows 3 (5, 6, 7, 8, 9) times more. 26 (28, 30, 32, 34, 36) sts Work straight until the armhole measures 6.5 (7, 7.25, 7.25, 7.75, 8)in, 16.5 (17.75, 18.5, 18.5, 19.75, 20.25)cm, ending with a WS row .

Neck Shaping

Cast off 4 (4, 5, 6, 8, 8) sts at the beginning of the next row. 22 (24, 25, 26, 26, 28) sts

Dec 1 st at neck edge on every row until 18 (20, 22, 22, 22, 23) sts remain, then work even until armhole measures 8.5 (9, 9.5, 10, 10.5, 10.75)in, 21.5 (23, 24, 25.5, 26.75, 27.25)cm, ending with a RS row.

Cast off 9 (10, 11, 11, 11, 12) sts at the beginning of the next WS row. Knit 1 row. Cast off remaining 9 (10, 11, 11, 11, 11) sts.

BACK

Cast on 121 (128, 142, 149, 163, 177) sts.

Row 1: K7(8,10,11,13,15), *PM, work Lace Panel, PM, k7(8,10,11,13,15); repeat from * to end of row.

Working all other stitches except Lace Panels in St st, work rows 2-8 of Lace Panel, then repeat Rows 1-8 once more, slipping all markers as you come to them.

****Dec Row:** K7(8,10,11,13,15), *work Lace Panel, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to 2 sts before next marker, k2tog; rep from

* four times more, work Lace Panel, k7(8,10,11,13,15).
 Work the next 17 (17, 15, 15, 15, 13) rows even in pattern.
 Rep from ** 1 (2, 3, 3, 3, 4) times more.
 Work 0 (2, 0, 0, 0, 2) rows even in pattern.

Size S Only:

Next Dec Rnd: K7, *work Lace Panel, sl1, k2tog, pssso; rep from * four times more, work Lace Panel, k7.
 Work 19 rows even in pattern.

All Sizes:

91 (98, 102, 109, 123, 127) sts.
 Work 2 rows in St st, removing markers along the row.
 Next row (RS): K17(13,16,16,14,19), *k2tog, k1(2,3,4,3,4), repeat from * to last 17 (13, 16, 15, 14, 18) sts, knit to end. 72 (80, 88, 96, 104, 112) sts
Next row: Purl.
 Work 20 (20, 20, 20, 24, 24) rows in St st, ending with a WS row.

Shape Armhole

Cast off 4 (4, 5, 6, 7, 8) sts at the beginning of the next two rows. 64 (72, 78, 84, 90, 96) sts
Next row: K2, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2.
Next row: Purl.
 Repeat the last 2 rows 3 (5, 6, 7, 8, 9) times more. 56 (60, 64, 68, 72, 76) sts
 Work even in pattern until armhole measures 8.5 (9, 9.5, 10, 10.5, 10.75) in, 21.5 (23, 24, 25.5, 26.75, 27.25)cm, ending with a WS row.

Right Shoulder

Next row: Cast off 9 (10, 11, 11, 11, 12) sts (leaving 1 live st on right hand needle), k8(9,10,10,10,10), turn.
Next row: Purl.

Cast off remaining 9 (10, 11, 11, 11, 11) sts.

Leave centre 20 (20, 20, 24, 28, 30) sts of back on holder for back neck.

Left Shoulder

With WS facing, rejoin yarn to beginning of work.

Next row: Cast off 9 (10, 11, 11, 11, 12) sts (leaving 1 live st on right hand needle), p8(9,10,10,10,10), turn.

Next row: Knit.
 Cast off remaining 9 (10, 11, 11, 11, 11) sts.

Sleeves (Make 2)

Cast on 44 (44, 44, 48, 48, 52) sts.
 Work 6 rows in moss stitch.
 Work 14 rows in St st, ending with a WS row.
Next row (RS): K2(2,2,3,3,4), *PM, work Lace Panel, PM, k2(2,2,3,3,4); repeat from * to end of row.
 Work the next 7 rows as set out for lace panel, working all other sts in St st, AT THE SAME TIME, inc 1 st at each end of the row on Rows 5 and 1 of the Lace Panel pattern sequence, until there are 52 (56, 62, 68, 72, 76) sts.

Work even in pattern until sleeve measures 17 (17, 17.5, 17.5, 18, 18)in, 43 (43, 44.5, 44.5, 45.75, 45.75) cm from cast on edge or desired length to underarm, ending with a WS row.

Cast off 4 (4, 5, 6, 7, 8) sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. 44 (48, 52, 56, 58, 60) sts
 Dec 1 st at each end of the next row, then every 4th row three times, then every other row 5 (6, 7, 8, 9, 10) times more. 26 (28, 30, 32, 32, 32) sts remain.
 Cast off 2 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Cast off all remaining sts.

Neckbands

Join shoulder seams.

With RS facing and beginning at top of Right Front at neck edge, pick up and knit 20 (20, 21, 22, 23, 24) sts up Right Front Neck, 3 sts down Right Back Neck, 20 (20, 20, 24, 28, 30) sts from Centre Back stitch holder, 3 sts up Left Back Neck, 20 (20, 21, 22, 23, 24) sts down Left Front Neck.
 Work 6 rows in moss stitch.
 Cast off all sts loosely.

Buttonhole Band

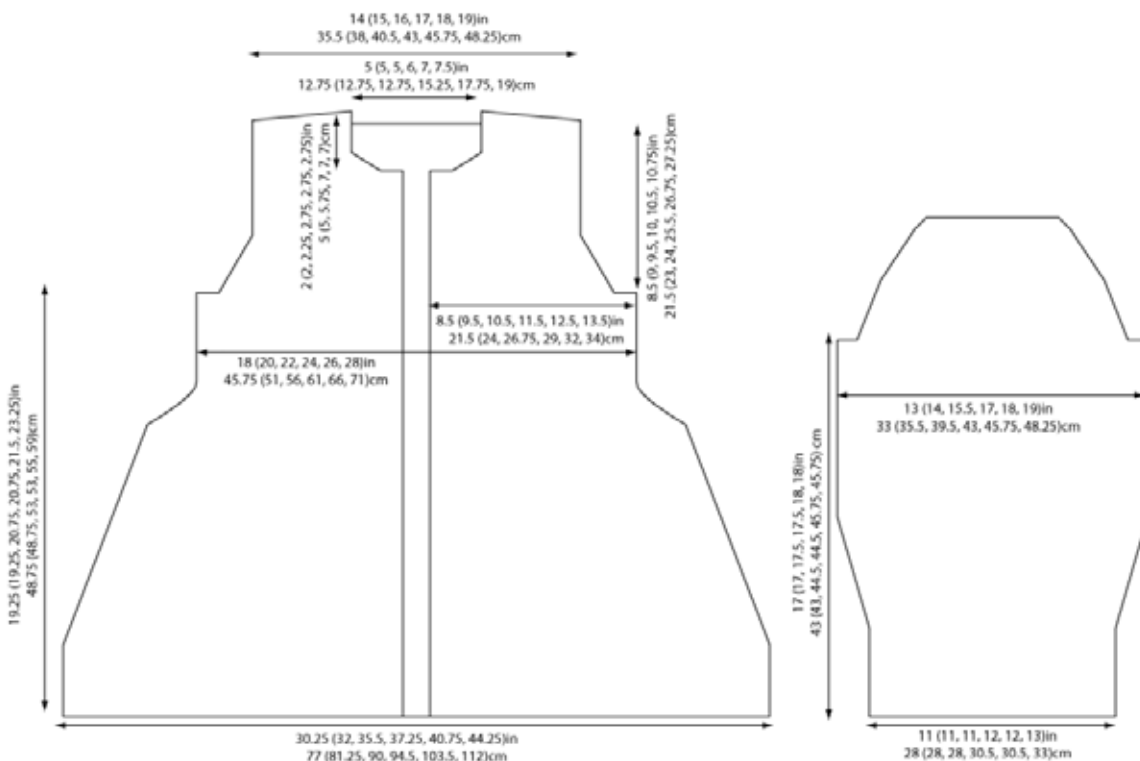
With RS facing and beginning at Right Front lower edge, pick up and knit 99 (105, 113, 113, 117, 127) sts along Right Front edge, picking up approximately 4 sts for every 5 rows.
 Work 2 rows in moss stitch.
Next row (WS, beginning at neck edge): (K1, p1) twice, * cast off 3 sts, (k1, p1) 5 (5, 5, 5, 6, 6) times, repeat from * 3 times more, work moss stitch to end of row.
Next row: Work in moss stitch, casting on 3 sts across each set of cast off sts on previous row.
 Work 2 rows in moss stitch.
 Cast off loosely.

Buttonband

With RS facing and beginning at Left Front top edge, pick up and knit 99 (105, 113, 113, 117, 127) sts along Left Front edge.
 Work 6 rows in moss stitch.
 Cast off loosely.

Making up

Set in sleeves. Sew sleeve and side seams. Block to measurements and weave in ends.
 Sew buttons to Left Front Buttonband to correspond with buttonholes.
